In Germany, we distinguish between patients subject to private and statutory health insurance. In order to be able to treat patients subject to statutory health insurance, that is, so-called panel patients, dentists have to sign a contract with the health insurance funds in which they undertake to charge the statutory health insurance only necessary, sufficient and cost-efficient services.

Today, however, the state of dental medicine offers to us dentists very many possibilities of teeth conservation or tooth replacement, which go far beyond what is necessary, sufficient and cost-efficient. Here in this practice, we dentists offer you the best options for your situation and your tooth, regardless of how you are insured. You then decide which treatment method or measure should be applied.
